We value having our employees return home to their families safely each evening. We are happy to have received the following recognition on behalf of our employees' efforts to be safe and watch out for one another.



For the fifth year in a row, Mountain Crane Service received the **SC&RA Safety Excellence** award. This was presented at the Annual Conference in Austin, TX earlier this month.

Two Mountain Crane Operators were recognized for the 2012 **SC&RA Operator Safety Award**. Craig Hall and Parker Chapman have both been mentored by other Mountain Crane operators and we are proud to have their accomplishments recognized by the industry.



Mountain Crane Service was also presented the AGC's **Platinum Safety Award**, the highest level given by the AGC, honoring construction firms who are 25% below the combined average of the OSHA Total Recordable and Lost Time Incidence Rates, and the average (1.0) EMR.
