Mountain Crane Service recently completed a major turnaround project at the Tesoro Refinery located in North Salt Lake. These shutdowns require extensive amounts of engineering lift plans, project management, and crane work. Planning for this project started last summer.

Mountain Crane provided over 20 pieces of equipment over the course of this two-month turnaround. Cranes selected specifically for this project ranged from 8.5 to 500 Ton Lifting Capacities and all different varieties including Rough Terrains, All Terrains, and Lattice Conventionals. The cranes were working 24/7 under the direction of Tesoro and multiple contractors, including B&W, Matrix, P2S, and IPWI.

This project required multiple skilled operators, experienced supervisors, a full-time engineer, and safety management in order to perform the necessary maintenance and repair work. Mountain Crane is proud of its team for not only completing another successful large-scale shutdown, but for doing so safely, with no time lost, and with zero accidents.




Employee Spotlight
