Honoring Our Fallen Soldiers



On Thursday, September 11, the Fort Douglas Museum hosted a ceremony remembering the 2,996 that died thirteen years ago, and to honor those who have fought for our freedom since.

The Utah Fallen Warrior Memorial was the backdrop for a crowd of military and local first responders. The event was open to the public, and the memorial can still be seen at the Fort Douglas Museum in Salt Lake City, Utah.

The monument is a piece of the slurry wall that surrounded the World Trade Center site.

Mountain Crane was honored to play a major role in bringing the 9/11 artifact to Utah. After a tour of over 6,000 miles, across 22 states, and 40 venues, the artifact now rests here, honoring our fallen warriors serving in Iraq and Afghanistan.


Mountain Crane Service recently took a group of key operations employees on a retreat to Wisconsin. With projects across the country, it's rare to have this many employees together at one time!

I-15 Bridge Girder Project



Phase one of a three phase project on Utah's Interstate -15 was completed at the end of August.

The 500 ton Liebherr LTM 1400 7.1 set 85,000 lb, 115' long precast concrete bridge girders along the 500 South exit of I-15 in Bountiful, Utah. The project had to be done overnight for minimal traffic flow. Mountain Crane will return to complete phase 2 & 3 of the project.

The outside lanes (completed) were put in place to widen the freeway. Until the project is completed, traffic will be re-routed & we will return to replace old, existing girders on the inside lanes.
