Liebherr LTM 1400 Projects



Mountain Crane's 500 Ton Liebherr LTM 1400 Hydraulic All Terrain Crane has had a busy couple of months! This crane is very versatile and can be found on a variety of jobsites.

The first job pictured was at the Jim Bridger Power Plant in Wyoming. The 500 Ton, in luffer and super lift configuration, pulled a header piece weighing 52,000 lbs. out of a building. The lift took approximately 286 ft. of boom as the header section was pulled out from 246 ft. in the air at an 85 ft. radius.

The second project featured was on the Snake River in Salmon, Idaho with Ralph L. Wadsworth Construction Company. After bridge girders were assembled on the accompanying roads, the crane then hoisted the bridge girders weighing approximately 140,000 lbs. into place across the river.

This was a very complex and long process; the crews had to work for a whole week straight, both day and night shifts to finish the project.



The last job featured was for Wanzek Construction in Adair, Iowa. Several nacelles weighing 195,000 lbs. each had to be unloaded from trucks and then set carefully onto the ground.

Mountain Crane is proud of its team for completing each of these various projects on time, prepared, and safety compliant.
