Vern, one of the founders of Mountain Crane, and his wife, Celia, recently returned from Cambodia after serving a two year LDS mission in that beautiful country. They had some amazing experiences and learned to love the humble and loving Cambodian people.

Most Cambodians are poor and work very long hours. It is typical for them to work 10 to 12 hours a day, six to seven days a week earning only \$ 80 to \$ 120 per month. Several members of a family will work to help with family expenses. Family is very important to them and in many cases extended family and the elderly parents live with the family and share the small home.

Many Cambodians have little shops, make things at home to sell, use motor bike as taxis, or try other ways to earn money. Living from day to day is common, but this type of practice doesn't help them be able to save and build for the future. Cambodia Job Foundation (CJF) was organized to help teach them how to build and grow their business, develop work skills, budgeting, saving money for a better future and become self-reliant. CJF organizes business teams to teach them "How to Start and Grow Your Own Business". The business teams identify promising business opportunities that could provide stable jobs.

Vern and Celia are helping support the growth of Cambodia Job Foundation through donations and other opportunities. This year, Mountain Crane is lifting lives by having CJF students/graduates hand-make Christmas cards.

Utah Valley Regional Medical Center



Mountain Crane is currently helping build the Utah Valley Regional Medical Center. Construction involves two new two story and twelve story structures being built on the south side of the hospital.

This crane is lifting and placing the rebar as crews prepare to pour the foundation of the twelve story structure in preparation for SME steel to erect the building. The crane is a Liebherr LR 1250 with 165 feet of main boom and 175 feet of luffer.

This is just a part of the larger project, continuing for several months. In January, Mountain Crane will return to the job site to lift the steel.
