Our wind maintenance and engineering team recently demonstrated their exceptional capabilities while addressing a critical issue for one of our valued customers. A main bearing failure required that the entire rotor be brought down as a whole unit. This presented a challenge as the rotor was only designed for disassembly on a piece-by-piece basis. This posed two major rigging restrictions: 1) It had to be large enough capacity to support the rotor and have enough contact surface area to not damage the blades. 2) We had to have the ability to rotate the load while descending.
