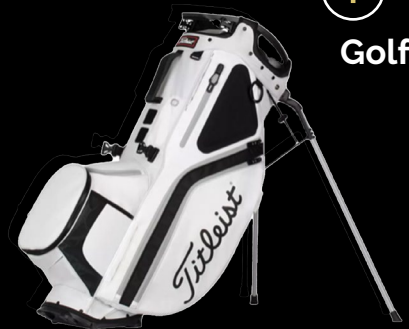

Tandem Bridge Lifts



Bridge building is a continual demand in construction and one we take pride in being a part of. Our teams recently placed the bridges in two areas allowing for expansion and development.

Utilizing our 400 and 200 ton all terrain cranes, we set a temporary access bridge along the Weber River in Morgan, Utah. The bridge had to be carefully rolled on skates to arrive at the appropriate location for both cranes to pick it up and set it in place. Once water levels decrease, we will return to set the permanent bridge.

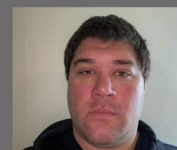
